

Hello! I am the new lieutenant for Sector 411. I have been with the department for 12 years and my last assignment was as a homicide sergeant. 2019 has gotten off to a bit of a violent start compared to 2018. There have been 19 violent crimes this year compared to 10 last year for a 90% increase. We have already had **eight citizens shot** in our sector while there was only one person shot at this time last year. Fortunately, nobody has lost their life because of violence this year in Sector 411, but there have been too many close calls. Most of the violence has been centered around Gilpin Court and Six Points (Highland Park). We have been focusing our efforts and resources in those areas to help reduce the violence.



While violence in the sector has increased, property crimes have decreased this year. We are having an issue with thefts from motor vehicles and motor vehicle thefts. Most of the thefts from vehicles have occurred because the car doors were unlocked or valuable items were left in plain sight. **Please lock your doors and don't leave valuables in sight.**



Many of the cars that were stolen were unlocked and running. Try to resist the urge to leave your car unattended while you warm it up in the morning...you may go outside and find that your warm car is gone!
