### When are elections held?

Presidential Primary – First Tuesday in March

All Other Primaries – Second Tuesday in June

November General Election – First Tuesday after the first Monday in November

### How frequently are elections for an office held?

Presidential – Every four years, even numbered years

U.S. Senate – Every six years, even numbered years (staggered terms for the two Senators)

U.S. House of Representatives -- Every two years, even numbered years

Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General – Every four years, odd numbered years

State Senate – Every four years, odd numbered years

House of Delegates – Every two years, odd numbered years

Sheriff, Treasurer and Commonwealth's Attorney – Every four years, odd numbered years

Circuit Court Clerk – Every eight years, odd numbered years

Mayor – Every four years, even numbered years

City Council and School Board – Every four years, even numbered years.
