Violent crime is up over the past 28 days in comparison to this time last year. Sector 211 had three homicides—two of which have been solved. Aggravated assaults have seen an increase and all have been cleared by arrest.

Property crimes have increased 87%. Residential burglaries, theft from motor vehicles, and motor vehicle theft continue to drive the crime in Sector 211. Please remember to lock the doors to your house and vehicle. A majority of the time crimes happen based on opportunity. Do not allow offenders the opportunity!
