How to Properly Recycle Household Batteries, Paint, Hazardous Waste and Tires

Household Batteries

Rechargeable and non-rechargeable alkaline, lithium, auto, AA, AAA, C, D and 9-volt batteries.

- Where: Clean Earth (formerly AERC Recycling) located at 3301 Rosedale Avenue
- When: Every Friday from 9 a.m. 3 p.m. Fee: \$0.75 a pound

Disposing of Paint, Hazardous Waste and Tires

- Where: East Richmond Road Convenience Center (ERRCC) is located at 3800 East Richmond Road, Richmond, VA 23223
- Hours of operation: 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays and 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Saturday

This service is free to Richmond residents who provide proof of residency, such as a valid driver's license, utility bill or vehicle registration.

Household hazardous waste items accepted at the East Richmond Road facility include:

- SolventsMineral spirits
- Paint thinner
- Turpentine
- Paints (limit: 20 gallons per month/per
 - household)
- Polyurethane
- Tung oil

- Stains
- Varnish
- Shellac
- Tints
- Lacquer thinners
- Paint reducers
- Primers
- Varsol
- Car fluids

- Motor oil
- Transmission fluid
- Antifreeze
- Car batteries (lead acid
- batteries only)
- Cooking oil
- Fuels
- Gasoline

- Gasoline additives
- #2 Fuel oil
 - Kerosene
 - Diesel
- Chain saw fuel
- Motor boat fuel
- Oil additives
- Propane tanks

NOTE: The ERRCC <u>cannot accept</u> acetone, *fire extinguishers, asbestos, road flares, herbicides or pesticides, explosives or materials that are shock-sensitive, radioactive or infectious*. Additionally, hazardous waste items from commercial entities or from persons living outside of the city limits are not accepted at the facility.

Tires

Tires with no rims are free. Note: there is a limit of 4 tires. Additionally, no off-road or oversized tires will be taken.

To Report Discarded Tires in your Alleyway or along the Roadside:
