Registration requires the completion of this form and submission of the $\$ 100.00$ annual fee. Failure to register shall result in a two hundred dollar (\$200.00) civil penalty or in a two hundred fifty dollar ( $\$ 250.00$ ) civil penalty if the property is located in a conservation or redevelopment area or in a designated blighted area. Upon re-occupancy, the owner shall notify the Department of Planning and Development Review in writing.
