This service is only available for City of Richmond Residents Bulk & Brush Collection - Coincides with the Bi-weekly Recycling Collection Bulk and Brush items will be collected during your recycling collection week. The items will be collected from the same location as household trash collection. Place the items next to your recycle cart. Contact the Central Virginia Waste Management Authority (CVWMA) at 340-0900 to verify your recycle collection day. Put items out by 6 a.m.

Brush/Twigs

Place items for collection next to your recycle cart. Make sure items are no larger than 6 feet long and 3 inches in diameter. Smaller twigs and smaller brush items need to be bundled and tied.

Prohibited Items

Tires, carpet, auto parts and construction debris

Same Day Request/Within 24 hours - Available for \$100 per request (with a receipt from our Administration Office, located in City Hall, Suite 704)

Collection of Appliances - Available for \$50 (per appliance/request)
