We at the Richmond City Sheriff's Office received a call from a concerned citizen about an inmate commissary package that was not delivered. We looked into this request and found that the commissary package in question was ordered from <u>inmatecarepackages.net</u>. The website for **Inmate Care Packages** is a SCAM that is not affiliated with our office and should not be used. This website shows 252 Better Business Bureau complaints for undelivered orders and lack of communication after a refund was requested.

Inmate Care Packages commissary/canteen is a SCAM. The website looks legitimate **inmatecarepackages.net** as it has a wide variety of commissary items that are commonly sold on inmate commissary. The website does however display one important red flag. In the payment section of the site states: "Unfortunately, **Inmate Care Packages** is unable to accept credit card payments at this time." The only payment options are Zelle, Cashapp, or paying with a money order.

To order commissary for your family member at the Richmond City Justice Center please use www.accesscatalog.com using the drop-down menu choose "Virginia" in the second drop-down menu choose "Jail- Richmond Package Program- VA" You can then register to purchase products for your family member that will be delivered to the Richmond Justice Center for delivery by our commissary staff.
