*In 2010, a partnership between the Richmond Police Department and local faith leaders created the Faith Leaders Partnership (FLP), in an attempt to bring faith organizations and law enforcement together to bridge relationships for the good of the community. The goal was to collaborate and try to curb violent crime within the city, while fostering a good relationship faith community.*



## Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing

The Richmond Families and Children Homeless Prevention Program is designed to assist families with children who are currently in unstable living situations. The program is financed through stimulus funds granted to the city of Richmond in June 2009.

Families will receive case management services, and financial assistance which may include rental assistance, credit repair, security and utility deposit payments and moving costs.

The department is also working with several community agencies to provide housing related legal assistance and services to single adults, victims of domestic violence, and ex-offenders.

Applicants to the program must be residents of the city of Richmond and meet certain income and eligibility criteria. If you would like additional information about the services available, please call (804)646-7532.

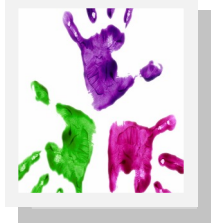
