MEDICAL EXAMINER FINDS DEATH OF INMATE DUE TO NATURAL CAUSES

RICHMOND, VA --- Sheriff C.T. Woody, Jr. today released the following statement regarding one of the three decedents who passed away while in custody last week: Said Sheriff Woody, "Today we were notified on a preliminary basis by the Office of the Medical Examiner that in the case of Javon Antoine Morris, his Manner of Death was of natural causes, and no foul play is suspected. His exact Cause of Death is still pending the results of the toxicology report, which may take several weeks." Sheriff Woody continued, "With regards to interest in the dual investigation into the deaths of Shawn Samuel and Zachary Tuggle, it is still ongoing, and we are leaving no stone unturned in the pursuit of facts. We wish to share additional facts when they are made available to us."
