DRUG ARREST MADE AT JOHN MARSHALL COURTHOUSE

RICHMOND, VA --- Sheriff C.T. Woody, Jr. reported today that a woman attempting to enter the John Marshall Courthouse was arrested yesterday for possession of marijuana.

On Monday, September 14, 2015 Sheriff's deputies assigned to the front security checkpoint at John Marshall Courthouse were performing a standard search of personal belongings when they discovered two bags filled with a green, leafy substance, concealed in the purse of Lindsey Carol Wells (18). The substance was field tested, weighed and identified as marijuana.

Ms. Wells was charged with simple possession (a misdemeanor) and released on a summons to appear in court on September 30.
