On Tuesday, November 22, Sheriff Woody and DJ Mike Street will deliver turkeys and other Thanksgiving fixings to 25 families who have loved ones spending the holiday at the RCJC.

“I’m very happy to be teaming up with Mike Street again to make sure families in Richmond have the best possible Thanksgiving,” said Sheriff Woody. “I have many blessings in my life, and as a Sheriff and a man, I feel it’s my responsibility to do what I can to share those blessings with others. When individuals are in a position to give back, we should. It’s the right thing to do, especially during the Holiday Season.”

Mike Street is in full agreement. “We appreciate the opportunity to team with the Sheriff’s Office in providing Thanksgiving meals to some of our neighbors who may not otherwise have been able to partake.
