Richmond City Sheriff's Office Launches Inmate Search Database This site will provide the public with search options and information for each inmate

Richmond, Va. (7/10/18) – The Richmond City Sheriff's Office has launched an inmate search database on the Richmond City Sheriff's Office <u>website</u>. The website will search the database and provide results for your search. It will allow the public to search by the individual's last name, first name, and inmate identification number to check if an individual is in our custody. The system will provide their booking date, bond amount, next court date, and charges placed. This information is updated in real-time. If the individual is housed at our facility, their name will appear with a "view details tab."

The view detail menu will provide additional information for each inmate. Once the user has clicked the tab, the inmate's next court date, bond amount, picture and charge description will appear.
