Third Precinct - Sector 312

Greetings,

The month of November has seen an increase in violent crime in Sector 312. Violent crime increased 13%, eight crimes in 2017 compared to nine crimes 2018. We had:

- 1 Homicide
- 3 Robbery of individual (two arrests made)
- 1 Robbery residence
- 2 Aggravated assaults (one arrest made)
- 1 Domestic aggravated assault (arrest made)

Property crime decreased from 89 to 77, for a 13% decrease compared to the same time last year. The biggest increase in property crimes was thefts of motor vehicles parts, inspection stickers, we had 10 this month compared to one the same time last year. We had a decrease in motor vehicle thefts, six compared with 11 last year same time period with four of those having keys left in the vehicle.

With the weather getting colder please do not leave your vehicle unattended while you let it warm up. This is the easiest way to let a thief steal your vehicle.

Things we can all do to prevent thefts from motor vehicles:

- * Lock your car doors;
- * Never leave valuables in your vehicle;
- * Do not leave coins in the open, and;
- * Report anything suspicious to the police.

Things we can all do to prevent auto thefts:

- * Remember to lock your car, and;
- * Never leave it running.

In addition to making your property a difficult target the most effective deterrent to these crimes is an active community.




