Summer Is On The Horizon!

Dear neighbor, summer is upon us!

As we venture out to enjoy all that this great city has to offer, please remember there is an element waiting to take advantage of any opportunity to ruin your great time. Although we have collectively taken action to reduce crime in our neighborhoods, and recorded a 23 percent reduction in major crime year-to-date, we must keep offenders on their heels to avoid losing ground.

During the month of May, violent crime decreased by 14 percent. However, property crime has increased 31 percent, up from 48 to 63 crimes during this same period last year. This increase was driven mostly by an increase in motor vehicle thefts and thefts from motor vehicles. *We can make an impact here.*

Of the nine motor vehicle thefts reported, compared to one the previous period, two cars were running and at least one was unlocked. In 19 of the 24 thefts from motor vehicles, the cars were either left unlocked or with items in plain view. I am certain you have heard this message before but please, <u>ALWAYS</u> lock your car! And take the keys and your property with you.

As you venture out, please remain vigilant and aware of your surroundings at all times. If you see or hear anything suspicious please call the police non-emergency number (804) 646-5100 or dial 911 in an emergency. Together we can get it done.
