## City Construction for Nine Mile Road Streetscape Project Starting Soon ~ Drivers can expect lane closures during construction ~

RICHMOND, Va. – The Department of Public Works will begin construction on the Nine Mile Road Streetscape Project starting Monday, April 5. The project includes installation of concrete sidewalks, bike lanes, curb extensions, underground utilities, decorative street lights, and landscaping along Nine Mile Road with construction starting at I-64 and moving west toward 25th Street.

There will be intermittent lane closures during construction. If complete street closures are needed for this project, they will be posted in advance to notify the public. Weather permitting, the project is expected to be complete by November.

Funding for the \$2.4 million project is shared through VDOT Revenue Sharing and city funds.
