Notes and Info for the 9th Street and 8th Street from Broad to Grace Streets closure: There will be intermittent lane closures along 9th and 8th streets from Broad to Grace Streets. Sidewalk, parking and one travel lane will be closed along 8th Street from Broad to Grace. A portion of the sidewalk between 8th and 9th along Broad will be closed.

The sidewalk along 9th Street and one travel lane from Broad to Grace will be closed.

Note1: The GRTC Bus Stop/ Pulse Station will be closed through July 30

Note 2: The eastbound Broad Street Government Station BRT Bus Lane from 8th to 9th streets will be closed for construction work on the General Assembly Parking Garage located at 200 North 9th Street. Sidewalk closures are already in place. GRTC will issue alternate bus route schedules and logistics.
