What is the CARE Program?

The City of Richmond's CARE
Program is designed to revitalize
and return economic viability to
mature neighborhood districts,
primarily in the city's low and
moderate-income communities.
New construction is ineligible.

WHAT'S COVERED?









The city will rebate up to \$25,000 for Exterior Rehabilitation, Interior Rehabilitation, Water Lateral Sprinkler System, or Security Improvements.

Examples include:

- Signage, roof repair, parking lot repaving, etc.
- Electrical, plumbing, flooring, painting, etc.
- Connection of a water lateral line and/or the installation of sprinkler or fire suppression systems
- Security cameras, installation of a security system, motion lights, etc.
