Notes and Info for the 9th Street and 8th Street from Broad to Grace Streets closure: There will be intermittent lane closures along 9th and 8th streets from Broad to Grace Streets. Sidewalk, parking and two travel lanes will be closed along 8th Street from Broad to Grace. A portion of the sidewalk between 8th and 9th along Broad will be closed. A *protected pedestrian sidewalk has been added to 9th Street between Broad and Grace streets.*



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Note 1: The GRTC Bus Stop/ Pulse Station and sidewalk along Broad Street from 8th to 9th streets will remain closed for 18 months (January 2023) to allow for construction of the General Assembly Building parking deck.

Note 2: The eastbound Broad Street Government Station BRT Bus Lane from 8th to 9th streets will be closed for construction work on the General Assembly Parking Garage located at 200 North 9th Street. Sidewalk closures are already in place. GRTC will issue alternate bus route schedules and logistics.
