



Wakefield Road Drainage Improvement Project

Project Information

This project will address the severe erosion within the existing channel in the neighborhood backyards and the consistent sediment buildup within the existing channel between Wakefield Road and Rattlesnake Creek (see figure below). The proposed improvements consist of approximately 1,000 linear feet of new storm drain pipe within the eroded swale between Stratford Road and Wakefield Road, replacement of the undersized culverts under Stratford Road and Wakefield Road, and improvements to the existing channel between Wakefield Road and Rattlesnake Creek.

All necessary easements have been acquired and private utility relocation is complete. The project design and environmental permit acquisition is complete.
