Sanitary Sewer Replacement Work – Libbie and Cary

Project Update

The sanitary sewer replacement project at Libbie and Cary has been underway since January 2023. The City of Richmond has been replacing deteriorated sewer mains which are at risk of imminent failure, reinstating associated sewer service laterals and making multiple repairs to a failing sewer main. The worksite is bounded to the north by Matoaka Road, to the south by Cary Street Road, to the east by Tuckahoe Blvd, and to the west by Maple Avenue.

Phase 2 of this project started on Tuesday, March 7 and requires the closure of Cary Street Road to thru traffic in both directions from Three Chopt Road to Tuckahoe Boulevard.

Safety Concerns

The City is aware of traffic concerns and have taken steps to help mitigate those, including:

- **Variable Message Boards** to redirect thru traffic away from the work zone and local neighborhoods. They are at these locations:
 - Huguenot Road
 - Malvern Road
 - Thompson Road
- **Traffic Signal Timing Adjustments** to improve traffic flow
- **Police Presence** to help deter speeding
- **Speed tables** to slow down thru traffic.
 - Speed table installation along interior streets adjacent to the project will begin on Tuesday, March 21. This work will require that individual streets be closed to allow for the install of each speed table. Speed table installations will take place one at a time to minimize disruption to interior neighborhood traffic and will only take place from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Temporary speed tables were approved by the Fire Marshall at the following locations
 - 0 block of Tuckahoe Blvd.
 - 0 block of Granite Ave.
 - 5400 block of Matoaka Rd.
 - 100 block of Libbie Ave.
 - Additional temporary speed tables were approved, and will be installed, at the following locations at a later date. Separate notice will be issued for these installations once materials are available for installation.
 - 5400 block of Tuckahoe Ave.
 - 100 block of N. Wilton Rd.
- **Additional Police and/or Security Presence** to help further deter speeding are being requested.
