MONTHLY FINANCE REPORT AS OF OCTOBER 31, 2016

Honorable Members of the Governing Council:

The Administration is pleased to present the October 31, 2016 Monthly Financial Report (MFR) pursuant to City Ordinance 2015-213-207.

This MFR is intended to provide informative and relevant financial data to City Council. The report includes highlights of the City's financial condition as of October 31, 2016 after the FY2016 year-end accrual reversals and adjustments have been made for the month of October. This financial information, which is unaudited, includes comparative General Fund revenues and expenditures to date for the periods ending October 31, 2015 and 2016, as well as comparison to the full year budget.

It should be noted that the numbers contained in this MFR are significantly impacted by the 2016 fiscal year-end closing process (accruals), timing differences in receipts and payments from the previous fiscal year, and the renewed efforts of the Finance Department to improve the financial reporting process. As a reminder, the City has a modified 45-day accrual period, where revenues and expenses occurring in September and the first half of October related to pre-June 30th activity is accrued back to the prior fiscal year.

As of October 31, 2016 General Fund revenues totaled \$78.0 million, or 10.9% of the budgeted annual revenue, which is more than the prior year. This is primarily due to timing differences/accruals in the City receiving sales tax (local and education), the accrual of personal property taxes, and the recording of personal property tax relief reimbursement and communications tax revenue from the Commonwealth. Exhibit 1 provides the budgetary comparison for revenues.

As of October 31, 2016, General Fund expenditures totaled \$153.8 million, or 21.4% of the budgeted expenditures. The major difference from the prior year is the timing of transfers out made to other funds. Exhibit 2 provides the budgetary comparison for expenditures.

Exhibit 3 presents General Fund revenues by categories and compares the revenues to date to the same period last year.

Exhibit 4 depicts General Fund budget and expenditure by agency for the period ending October 31, 2016.

Exhibit 5 provides summary encumbrances by department totaling \$21.2 million. Department of Public Works (DPW) and Information Technology (DIT) are agencies with large encumbrances. DPW's encumbrances are for grass cutting, leaf collection, waste and trash removal services.

DIT's encumbrances are for paper and printing services, wireless communication and other information technology services for the City.

Exhibit 6 shows a graphical depiction of the City-wide operating cash and investment balances on a month-to-month basis for the fiscal years 2013 to 2017.

Exhibit 7 is a chart of the City's outstanding long term debt as of June 30 for FY2013, FY2014, FY2015, and FY2016 as well as, the debt related activity for the period ending October 31, 2016. Outstanding General Fund supported debt, including debt for Schools capital projects, has grown from \$594.1 million to \$613.3 million. During this same period the debt associated with School capital projects related from \$115.3 million at the end of 6/30/2013 to \$185.1 million as of October 31, 2016. During FY2015, the City created a Parking Enterprise Fund, and moved the City's parking assets and associated debt into the self-supporting Enterprise Fund. City debt used to finance the Coliseum Parking Garage and the former RMA Expressway Parking Garage is now paid from the Parking Enterprise Fund.

Exhibit 8 provides the snap-shot of accounts payable aging as of October 31, 2016 as well as the month-to-month aging beginning in October 2015. It is pertinent to point out that since October 2015, there has been dramatic improvement in outstanding accounts payable, which has declined from \$2.6 million to \$.7 million, a decrease of \$1.9 million, attributable to the renewed efforts by Department of Finance in ensuring vendor payments are made in a timely manner.

Exhibit 9 provides the breakdown of the delinquent tax figures. It is important to point out that a large portion of delinquent taxes reported on June 30, 2016 were collected in October and accrued as revenues to FY2016.

Exhibit 10 highlights various economic indicators for the City of Richmond.

We would like to thank all City agencies, departments and staff for their assistance and cooperation in providing timely and accurate information in support of the preparation of this report.










