Honorable Members of the Governing Council:

The Administration is pleased to present the August 31, 2017 Monthly Financial Report (MFR) pursuant to City Ordinance 2015-213-207.

This MFR is intended to provide informative and relevant financial data to City Council. The report includes highlights of the City's financial condition as of August 31, 2017. This financial information, which is unaudited, includes comparative General Fund revenues and expenditures to date for the periods ending August 31, 2016 and 2017, as well as comparison to the full year budget.

It should be noted that the numbers contained in this MFR will be impacted by the 2017 fiscal year-end closing process (accruals), timing differences in receipts and payments from the previous fiscal year, and the renewed efforts of the Finance Department to improve the financial reporting process. As a reminder, the City has a modified 45-day accrual period.

As of August 31, 2017 General Fund revenues totaled \$16.1 million, or 2.0% of the budgeted annual revenue. This is primarily due to timing differences/accruals in the City receiving real estate taxes, sales tax (for education), and the accrual of personal property taxes. Exhibit 1 provides the budgetary comparison for revenues.

As of August 31, 2017, General Fund expenditures totaled \$94.1 million, or 13.6% of the budgeted expenditures, which is less than the prior year. Exhibit 2 provides the budgetary comparison for expenditures.

Exhibit 3 presents General Fund revenues by categories and compares the revenues to date to the same period last year.

Exhibit 4 depicts General Fund budget and expenditure by agency for the period ending August 31, 2017.

Exhibit 5 provides summary encumbrances by department totaling \$10.7 million. City Sheriff and Department of Fire and Emergency Services are agencies with large encumbrances.

Exhibit 6 shows a graphical depiction of the City-wide operating cash and investment balances on a month-to-month basis for the fiscal years 2013 to 2018.

Exhibit 7 is a chart of the City's outstanding long term debt as of August 31 for FY2014, FY2015, FY2016, FY2017 as well as, the debt related activity for the period ending August 31, 2017. Outstanding General Fund supported debt, including debt for Schools capital projects, has

decreased from \$711.2 million to \$653.9 million. During this same period the debt associated with School capital projects related from \$140.8 million at the end of 6/30/2014 to \$184.8 million as of August 31, 2017.

Exhibit 8 provides the snap-shot of accounts payable aging as of August 31, 2017 as well as the month-to-month aging beginning in August 2016.

Exhibit 9 provides the breakdown of the delinquent tax figures.

Exhibit 10 highlights various economic indicators for the City of Richmond.

We would like to thank all City agencies, departments and staff for their assistance and cooperation in providing timely and accurate information in support of the preparation of this report.

as of AUGUST 31, 2017








