Sector 411 had a very successful 2017. Our officers did a great job reducing both violent crimes and property crimes compared to 2016. Unfortunately, we did have an increase in murders from 7 in 2016 to 10 in 2017. We had a total reduction of all violent crimes in 411 of 13%. We did even better with property crimes. We saw a major reduction in Burglaries of 27%. We had a 23% reduction in motor vehicle thefts. Our total for all property crimes showed a reduction of 14%. (See detailed stats to the right)

But we cannot rest on our past achievements. With the weather being so cold recently people have been leaving their cars unlocked and running to warm them up. **Please don't do this.** We had 7 MVTs last cycle and 6 of them were left running. Also, we saw a 56% increase in thefts from motor vehicles last cycle (9 to 14). 11 of those cars were left unlocked. We did arrest a juvenile male in late December which will hopefully reduce crimes this coming cycle. We got a great tip from a citizen who called 911 and gave the officers a very detailed description about the suspect who was rummaging through her car. The officers responded quickly and this juvenile was arrested a few blocks away with stolen property on his person!
